Park House in Paignton was originally a hotel that was converted into an Abbeyfield House in 1997. It is situated in a private road facing Victoria Park. The shopping centre of Paignton is within an easy, level walk of a few minutes or a pleasant walk across the park leads to the main shops or the library. The main Post Office, supermarket and the usual facilities of a small town are all conveniently accessible.

The main railway station is only a few minutes walk with trains to London and other areas of Devon. The bus station is also nearby with a regular bus to Exeter, Teignmouth/Dawlish, Newton Abbot, Torquay, Totnes, Brixham, Kingswear and ferry service to Dartmouth.

The sea front of Paignton is only two minutes walk where there are hotels, restaurants, the pier and an eight screen cinema. The harbour is also a pleasant place to pass the time watching the boats. There are many clubs and societies for anyone wishing to socialise or follow their particular interest.

The busy resort of Torquay is a few minutes away by bus or train and offers a wider range of shops and splendid leisure facilities.

The House Manager and staff provide lunch and a light evening meal served in the dining room. Residents prepare their own breakfasts to eat as and when they like in their own rooms. There are eleven rooms, each with ensuite facilities, a purpose built-in kitchen corner with space for kettle, toaster and small fridge, etc. The rooms are carpeted ready for residents to furnish with their own belongings, subject to current safety standards. Television and telephone points are provided plus a personal alarm. The rooms are on three floors, accessible by staircase or lift. Domestic staff maintain all public areas and clean residents' rooms.

Residents are encouraged to follow their own interests and activities, join in any of the events organised by the House Committee and invite their relatives and friends to visit them.
