



How to make a Frog House

Difficulty level: Easy

What it's for

Frogs and toads don't hibernate, but they are still inactive over the winter. Frogs will prefer wetter conditions than toads, but they don't drown as they can breathe through their skin!

What you will need

- A trowel
- A clay pot
- Damp leaves
- A watering can or bottle

How to build it

1. Dig a small hole in a damp and shaded spot.
2. Place a clay pot on its side in the hole.
3. Bury the pot halfway up the sides and fill it half way with soil.
4. Add some damp leaves for warmth.
5. If the area is dry, sprinkle it with water using a watering can or bottle – this will help keep it in place.
