There is an attractive communal TV lounge-dining room, a spacious conservatory and pleasant gardens for enjoyable days outside in the fresh air. There are also laundry facilities and a hair salon.

We also have entertainment afternoons where we have enjoyed performances by a ukulele band, a professional vocalist and keyboard duo, and the local school choir.

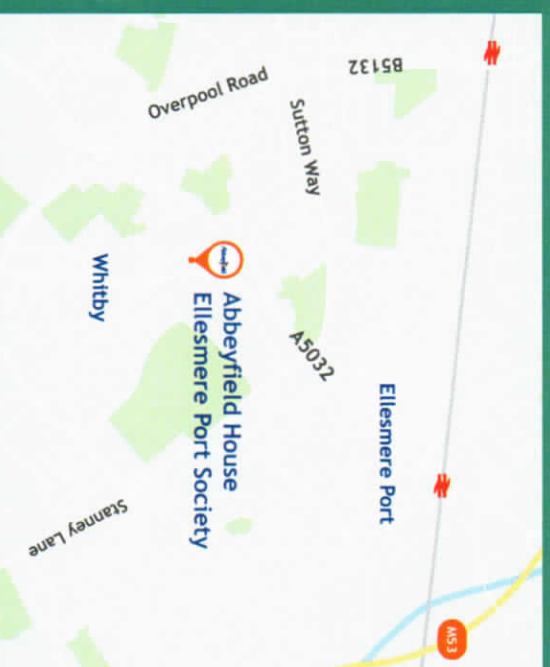
Of course, it's entirely up to you whether you want to join in, or want to take advantage of the peace and quiet for a bit of solitude in our lovely conservatory.

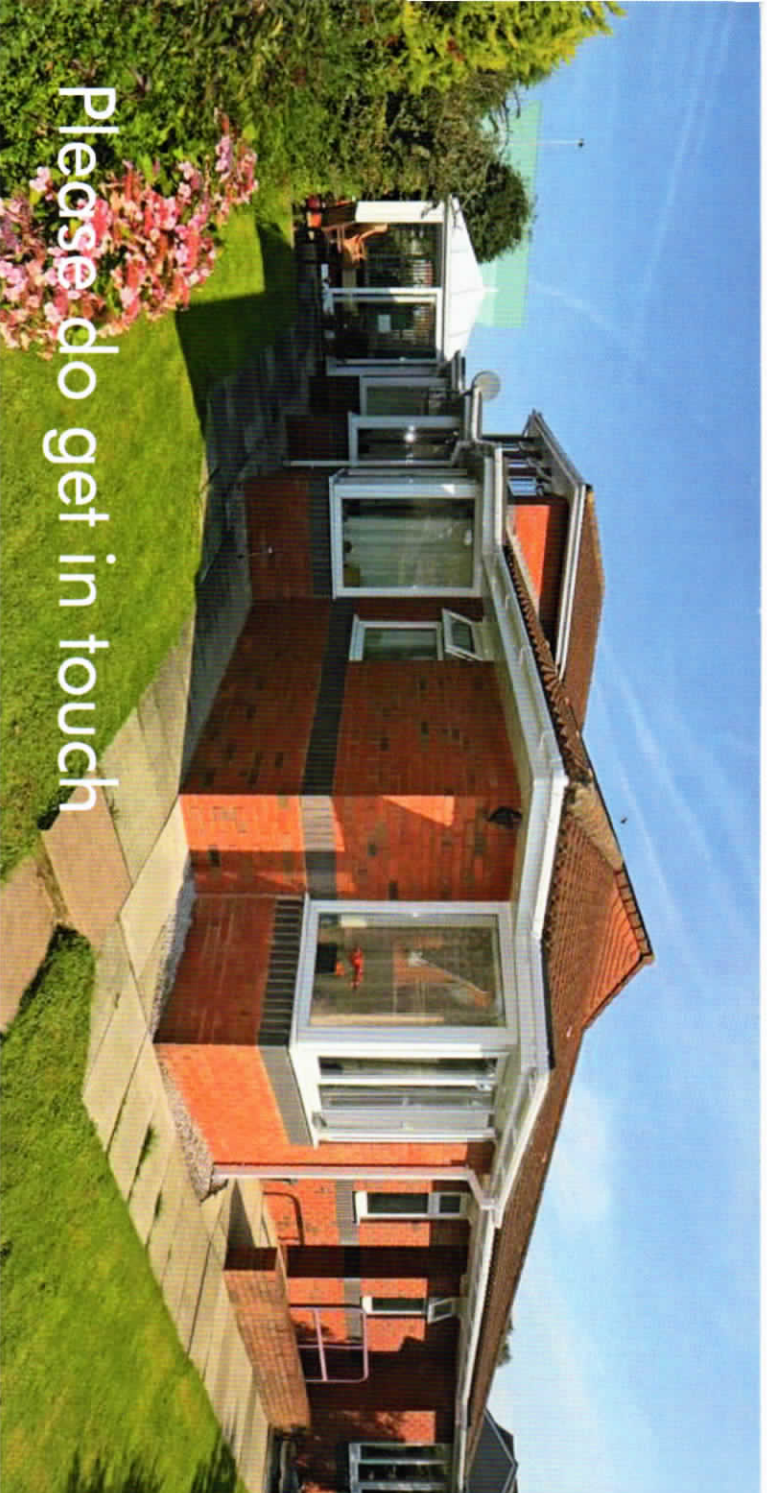
Your community
