Delicious, daily home-cooked meals and everyday housekeeping are organised and all your household bills are included in the cost, leaving you free to enjoy your time

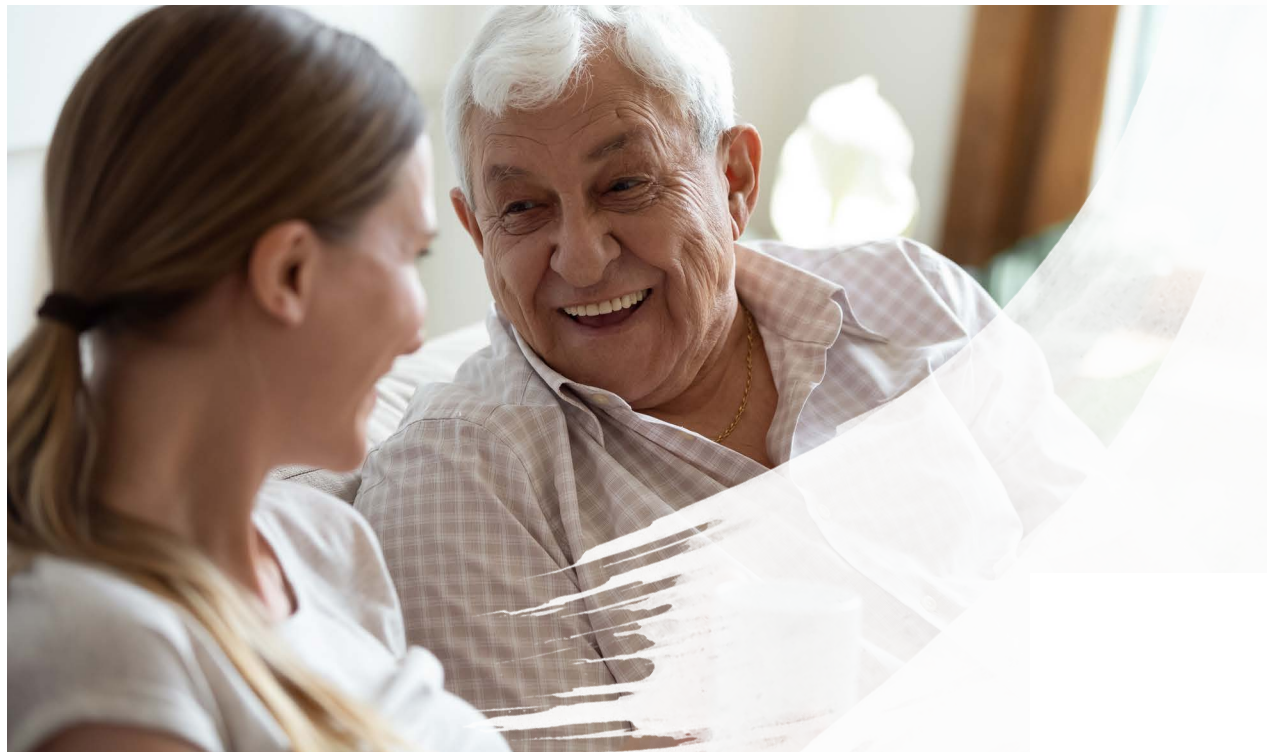


Happiness starts with you

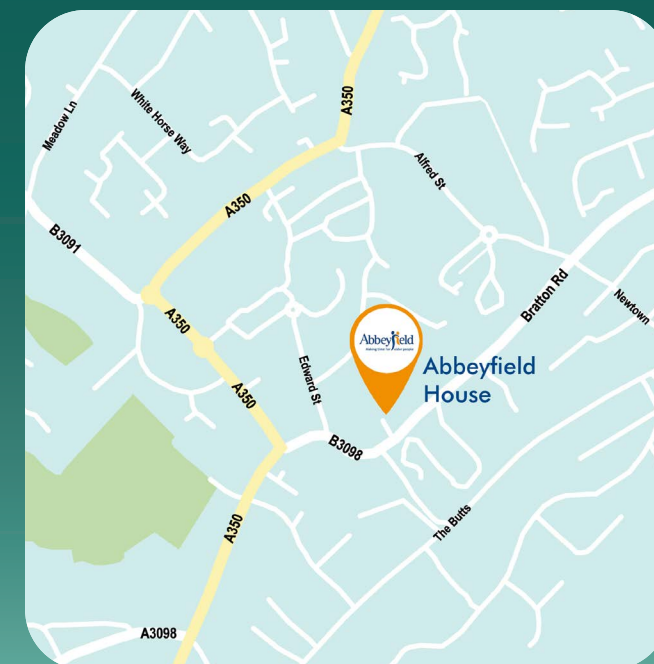
Making time for you is at the heart of everything we do.
