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Hatch Mill

RESIDENTIAL & NURSING HOME | FARNHAM

Hatch Mill is a two-storey, residential care and nursing home for older people, located in Farnham, Surrey. The home is set amid well-maintained, landscaped gardens with a central courtyard garden and pond.

THE LOCATION

Positioned on the edge of the beautiful Georgian town centre of Farnham, Hatch Mill is not far from a bus route and train station serving the local area and London. Within a ten minute walk there are an array of local shops, restaurants and facilities such as the leisure centre and arts centre.

THE GARDEN

The home is set in well laid out grounds with a large central Japanese courtyard garden. There are several mature trees, flowering shrubs and a natural pond, all of which are well maintained and give a pleasant picture for residents to view.

THE ACCOMMODATION

Hatch Mill has a total of forty-six bedrooms over the ground and first floor. Two are double bedrooms, the remainder being single rooms.

The bedrooms are all en-suite with basin and toilet; some also have a wet room. There are two bathrooms and a shower room downstairs and two bathrooms and two shower rooms upstairs. There is a dining room and a residents' lounge on each floor and a large sun lounge downstairs at the front of the building.

HIGH QUALITY CUISINE

Hatch Mill's on-site chefs produce a delicious and varied selection of home cooked dishes made from fresh locally sourced ingredients daily.

Individual dietary needs and food preferences are always catered for by the chefs and our team ensure every meal at the home is an occasion to be enjoyed by all.

From time to time Hatch Mill's residents celebrate world cuisines, national events and traditional UK occasions by taking part in our themed lunches where plenty of fun is had by all.

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Wey Valley House

CARE HOME | FARNHAM

Wey Valley House offers residents a homely and secure care environment within a well equipped home in a wonderful location.

LOCATION

The home is situated on the outskirts of Farnham town centre and is not far from a bus route and train station that serves the local area and London.

Wey Valley House sits by the side of the River Wey and has access from the garden onto the river's towpath which leads into the many facilities within the lovely Georgian town centre.

Having been designed as a purpose built care home in 1985, it was completely refurbished in 2008 and now provides a wonderful environment for residents to both relax and enjoy socialising.

BEAUTIFUL RIVERSIDE GARDENS

The home benefits from pleasant gardens with a patio area overlooking the river. There are several large, mature trees, a number of interesting shrubs and flowering tubs all of which are well maintained and give a pleasant picture for residents to view.



SPACIOUS EN-SUITE ROOMS

There are a total of twenty-six bedrooms on the ground and first floor, all of which are single rooms. The bedrooms are en-suite with a toilet and hand basin while some also benefit from having their own showers. Each room enjoys plenty of natural light, is well decorated, carpeted, has free standing wardrobes, and call bells.

SERIOUS ABOUT FOOD

The team of on-site chefs take pride in providing all our residents with a varied and nutritious menu produced from locally sourced fresh ingredients where possible. Special diets and food preferences will also be catered for.

The Society's belief that every meal should be an occasion certainly rings true within Wey Valley House and drinks and snacks are also served throughout the day together with fresh fruit.

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Ridgway Court

CARE HOME | FARNHAM

Ridgway Court is a two-storey residential care home for older people and is situated in a prime location within the Georgian town of Farnham in Surrey.

LOCATION

The home is within easy reach of Farnham town centre and is not far from a bus route and train station that serves the local area and London.

Nearby are local shops including a small Tesco Express, butcher and a lovely fresh bakery.

THE HOME

Ridgway Court has been converted from two residential houses and provides 16 residential care places.

The home is set in well laid out gardens with a patio area and pleasant gazebo. There are several mature trees and a number of shrubs, all of which are well maintained and give a pleasant picture for residents to enjoy.

REAL HOMELY FEEL

There are a total of 16 bedrooms, on the ground and first floor. All bedrooms are single rooms. 14 bedrooms are en-suite with basin, toilet and shower or bath, the other two rooms only have hand basin and toilet; however, this is reflected in the fees of these rooms.

All rooms are well decorated with fitted wardrobes and call bells in situ. Each room enjoys good natural light and views vary from bedroom to bedroom.

The bedrooms have a good degree of privacy and residents are encouraged to personalise their rooms with furniture and pictures. The home really does have a wonderfully cosy feel to it and residents enjoy a unique family environment.



EAT, DRINK & BE HAPPY

Ridgway Court residents enjoy fine home cooked meals together in their dining room.

Nutritious menus are prepared by the chefs and our ever popular themed lunches, celebrating world cuisines, national events and traditional UK occasions provide a great excuse to celebrate life throughout the year.

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Castle Gate

SHELTERED HOUSING | GUILDFORD

Castle Gate provides sheltered accommodation for up to eight residents with the services of a resident House Manager.

INDEPENDENT CENTRAL GUILDFORD LIVING

The house is located just a few minutes walk from Guildford High Street and is adjacent to the beautiful castle grounds. Designed to foster continuing independence for more active older people, Castle Gate provides an ideal setting with plenty of amenities on hand.



SUPPORT & COMPANIONSHIP

The House Manager provides two main meals a day served in the spacious dining room and also supplies the basic ingredients for residents to make their own breakfast and afternoon tea in their room.

Residents' rooms are cleaned once a week by the Abbeyfield team and the home has a well equipped laundry room for all to use.



FRIENDSHIP AT HOME

Castle Gate has a large homely lounge with a television which all residents can use. A ground floor lift allows easy access to all upstairs rooms if needed.

The bed-sitting rooms vary in size but all are en-suite and have a hot plate and fridge.

We always encourage residents to personalise their living space with their own unique belongings. For security and safety, all rooms have an emergency call system with a personal alarm pendant connecting them to an external monitoring unit.

The light, airy conservatory at Castle Gate is a perfect communal area for residents to meet together to watch television or play games. The attractive garden with views to the castle, is an ideal place to relax with friends on a sunny afternoon.

Regular groups and activities such as painting, keep fit classes and film and game nights are organised depending on resident demand.

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Roundhay

SHELTERED HOUSING | GUILDFORD

Roundhay provides sheltered accommodation for up to ten residents with the services of a resident House Manager. The house is located a mile from Guildford town centre, with a local bus service nearby.

SUPPORTED INDEPENDENCE

The house is designed to foster continuing independence for more active older people, whilst providing amenities to prevent loneliness and to provide companionship.

The House Manager provides two main meals a day served in the spacious dining room and also supplies the basic ingredients for residents to make their own breakfast and afternoon tea in their room. There is a large, homely lounge with a piano for all residents to

use and a stair-lift to allow access to all floors if needed. There is also an on-site hairdressing salon and laundry room for residents' use.

THE ACCOMMODATION

The bed-sitting rooms vary in size but all are en-suite and have a kitchenette area to enable the independent preparation of breakfast and snacks.

We encourage residents to personalise their living space with furniture items, ornaments and pictures.

For security and safety, all rooms have an emergency call system and each resident has a personal alarm pendant connected to an external monitoring unit.

This enables residents to live a truly independent lifestyle knowing they have the support and back up of Abbeyfield's care professionals, if needed.

PLENTY OF ROOM FOR VISITORS

Roundhay has a relaxed atmosphere where residents are encouraged to invite visitors and family, with parking available at the front of the building.

All are welcome to use the communal areas and the home's well maintained garden is a perfect place to entertain.

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Kemnal

SHELTERED HOUSING | HASLEMERE

The house provides seven residents with secure sheltered housing together with the support and services of the House Manager.

LOCATION

Kemnal is a spectacular, grade two listed building situated on the outskirts of Haslemere in Surrey. There is a bus service located close by with a direct link into the extensive arts, culture and retail facilities that nearby Guildford has to offer. The pretty and well equipped town centre of Haslemere which provides an array of independent local shops and restaurants is also easily accessible via a five minute bus journey from Kemnal.



THE HOUSE

The House Manager provides two main meals a day served in the spacious dining room and also supplies the basic ingredients for residents to make their own breakfast and afternoon tea in their room.

There is a large, homely lounge which all residents can use and a ground floor stair-lift for access to all floors if needed.

The well equipped on site laundry is available for use daily and the bed-sitting rooms are all en-suite and have a kettle and fridge.

For security and safety, all rooms have an emergency call system and each resident has a personal alarm pendant connected to an external monitoring unit, allowing full peace of mind for all residents and their families.

COMPANIONSHIP

As with all Abbeyfield Wey Valley homes, residents at Kemnal enjoy a relaxed atmosphere and are encouraged to invite visitors and family. There is plenty of parking available at the front of the house and everyone is welcome to use the communal areas. The splendid summer house within the grounds is a favourite for many residents to relax and entertain family and friends.
