Steeped in history, Buckmaster House was opened in 1895 by Jane Buckmaster as a charity, it was purpose built as a residential home to provide recuperation for ladies in Brixton. Though its use has changed over the years, the distinguished home continues to offer the highest standards to its residents and combines the grace of an era past with all the conveniences of the present day.

Elegance and superb craftsmanship is evident throughout the House and many of the original features are still visible today particularly in the main hall with its sweeping staircase and dome, which provides a suitably impressive entrance to Buckmaster House.

There are 21 en-suite rooms, two of which are double rooms designed for couples, and are all furnished to a high standard.

The main communal lounge has plenty of comfortable chairs to relax and socialise in, whilst our wonderful sun lounge is small and quiet, but boasts glorious south-facing views over the sea and gardens. There is also a lovely sun terrace where you can sit with friends or visitors and admire the scenery.

Our large, bright, dining room also has sea views and provides a delightful setting for your meals.

The House has lift access and parking on site. A short trial stay can be arranged, on request.

You can't enjoy peace of mind without trust. This is why Buckmaster House is registered and regulated by Homes England.

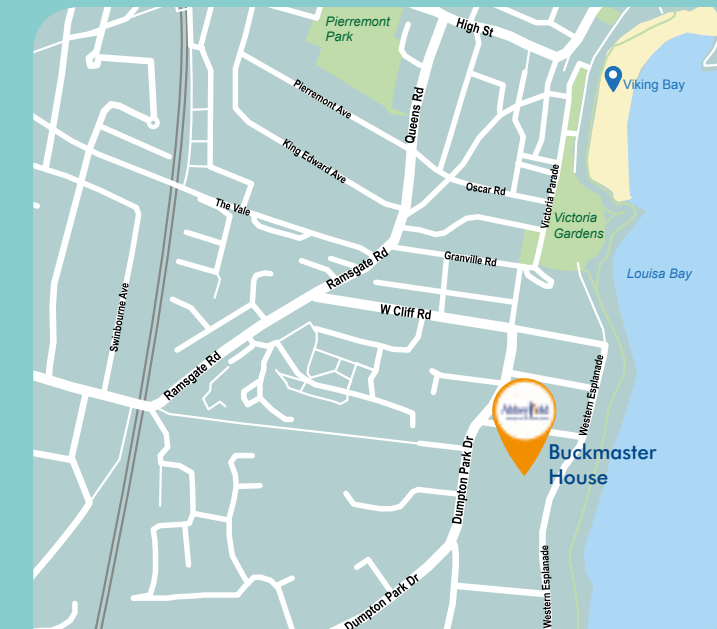
But our quality control doesn't end there – the opinions of our residents matter too. We have regular resident and family meetings, so we can get feedback on how we can improve our service at the home.
